SECTION-2 BIDDERS TO INFORM FULLY

2.1 INTRODUCTION:

- 2.1.1. Tripura Power Generation Limited (TPGL), A Government of Tripura Enterprise, erstwhile Tripura State Electricity Limited is having two gas based Thermal Power Stations located at Baramura & Rokhia in the State of Tripura. There are 2x21 MW BHEL make Frame-V Gas Turbine Units at Baramura Power Plant and 3x21 MW BHEL make Frame-V Gas Turbine Units at Rokhia Power Plant supplied & commissioned by BHELin different phases.
- 2.1.2. In order to ensure safe & reliable operation of Gas Turbine Units at GTPS, Baramura, Deputy General Manager, Gas Thermal Electrical Division, Baramura on behalf of TPGL has invited e-tender for selection of vendors for the work of 'Running & maintenance of 2X21 MW Frame-5 GT Unit no. 4 & 5 at GTPS, Baramura / Supply of Coalescing Filter Element with Tank Gasket for Oil Mist Eliminator Make- Dollinger' and providing 18 (eighteen) months warranty for satisfactory performance of filters including insurance coverage of materials supplied during warranty period.
- **2.2 LOCATIONS OF INSTALLATION:** Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura, Khowai District in Tripura.

2.3 MODE OF EXECUTION OF PROGRAMME:

- 2.3.1 The basis of evaluation of the bids shall be the cost/rate quoted in the Price Schedule. To further clarify, cost of design, manufacture, testing & supply of Coalescing Filter Element with Tank Gasket for Oil Mist Eliminator Make- Dollinger etc. shall be inclusive of transportation, transit insurance and taxes as applicable and providing 18 (eighteen) months warranty for satisfactory performance of filters including insurance coverage of materials supplied during warranty period. The bidders are required to quote rate / cost on firm basis and no price variation on any account shall be considered.
- 2.3.2 The successful bidder shall provide warranty for 18 months from the date of installation with free replacement against manufacturing defects, normal wear & tear during warranty period
- 2.3.3 The Programme shall be carried out as given here under:-
- 2.3.3.1 The contractor shall be allowed to execute the order conforming to the specifications mentioned in this document after clearance from TPGL.
- 2.3.3.2 The work covers design, manufacture, testing & supply of Coalescing Filter Element with Tank Gasket for Oil Mist Eliminator Make- Dollinger for 21 MW BHEL make Frame-5 Gas Turbine Units at Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura, Tripura and providing warranty for 18 (eighteen) months from the date of installation of full quantity of filter elements including insurance coverage of materials supplied during warranty period.
- **2.4 TENDER FEE:-Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred) only** are to be paid on-line by using NET Banking only through e-tender portal at the time of submission of bids. (Non-refundable).
- 2.5 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):Rs. 9,150.00/- (Rupees nine thousand one hundred fifty) only are to be paid on-line by using NET Banking only through e-tender portal at the time of submission of bids.
- 2.6 PROCEDURE FOR DEPOSITING TENDER FEE (TF) AND EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

- 2.6.2 After initiating the Bid Submission Process from "My Tender" option, an "Online Payment" page will appear which will display the total TF & EMD.
- 2.6.3 On submission of TF & EMD payment option, System will redirect to the SBI Bank MOPS window.
- 2.6.4 SBI MOPS will have two options for Net Banking "SBI" & "Other Bank". Bidder can choose any of the options as desired and can complete the Online Payment process.

2.7 RELEASE OF EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

- 2.7.1 EMD amount shall be refunded to all the bidders including successful bidder in their respective Bank accounts, after the Letter of Award (LoA) is uploaded in the e-procurement Portal <u>http://tripuratenders.gov.in</u>, on receipt of Performance Bank Guarantee from the successful bidder.
- 2.7.2 The EMD of the successful bidder may be forfeited along with other penal actions as deemed fit by the TPGL if the L1 bidder fails to execute the Contract Agreement within the stipulated period after issuance of Letter of Award (LoA) or fails to submit Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated period, after acceptance of the Letter of Award (LoA).
- 2.7.3 If any bidder withdraws his offer after opening Technical Bid before opening of Price bid or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the quotation which are not acceptable to the Tendering Authority, 100% of the deposited EMD may be forfeited.

- 1.3 The "CONTRACTOR" or "SUCCESSFUL BIDDER" shall mean shall mean the Firm/ Person (whose tender has been accepted by TPGL) and shall include his legal representatives, successor in interest and assignees.
- 1.4 The *"CONTRACT"* shall mean "Running & maintenance of 2X21 MW Frame-5 GT Unit no. 4 & 5 at GTPS, Baramura / Supply of Coalescing Filter Element with Tank Gasket for Oil Mist Eliminator Make- Dollinger" and shall be valid till the completion of all related works.
- 1.5 "**BIS**" shall mean specifications of Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS);
- 1.6 "IEC" shall mean specifications of International Electro-technical Commission;
- 1.7 **"Bids**" shall mean the Technical Bid and the Price Bid submitted by the Bidder electronically at the prescribed web portal, in response to the e-bid document, in accordance with the terms and conditions hereof;
- 1.8 **"Bid Deadline"** shall mean the last date and time for submission of Bid in response to the NIe-T and as may have been extended in accordance with the e-bid document;
- 1.9 **"Bidder"** shall mean a Bidding Company complying with the provisions of **SECTION 3**;
- 1.10 **"Commissioning"** means successful operation of the Gas turbine with supply & installation of Mist Eliminator Filter Elements as defined in DNIe-T.
- 1.11 **"Completion of work"** means the Project / Works has been completed as per Technical Specifications as per DNIe-T.
- 1.12 **"Price Bid"** shall mean the e-Bid, containing the Bidder's quoted cost for design, manufacture, testing & supply of Coalescing Filter Element with Tank Gasket for Oil Mist Eliminator Make-Dollinger for 21 MW Frame-V Gas Turbine Units at Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura. Tripura in the **PART -B** of the e-bid document;
- 1.13 **"Statutory Auditor"** shall mean the auditor of a company appointed under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 or under the provisions of any other applicable governing law;
- 1.14 **"Security Deposit"** shall mean the bank guarantee to be provided from a Selected Bidder to the TPGL in accordance with the prescribed Format.
- 2 In case the contractor/ bidder fails to execute the said work within stipulated time, "TPGL" will be at liberty to get the work executed from the open market without calling any tender/e-tender and without any notice to the contractor/ bidder, at the risk and cost of the contractor/ bidder. Any additional cost incurred by "TPGL" shall be recovered from the contractor/ bidder. contractor/ bidder (with proof of evidence of such delay) is received before the expiry of the agreement period, or any extended period granted to the contractor/ bidder.

- 4 The relevant clauses, terms & conditions of Agreement shall remain valid upto the date of completion as per Letter of Award (LoA) or the extended period granted by TPGL.
- 5 It will be the sole responsibility of the contractor/ bidder, to execute orders placed as per time schedule, and to ensure quality parameters, specifications and other requirements provided in the e-tender document and as per agreement.
- 6 In the interest of the work and the program, agreement executed between the contractor/bidder and the "TPGL" may be extended to a mutually agreed period, if the need so arises. - 7.4 Any bid received without the test certificates will be summarily rejected for non-responsive to the tender condition.
- **8 SPECIFICATIONS:** General specifications of filters are given at PART 4 of this NIe-T. If there is any left out specifications, the same shall be as per the latest Guidelines of BHEL/GE.

- 9.1 The successful bidder should be responsible for packing, forwarding and dispatching, insurance and safe delivery of materials including loading & unloadingat site at their quoted price. Temporary storage of materials during transit or at site shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder at his risk and cost.
- 9.2 The Letter of Award (LoA) for the works may be placed with the successful bidder by TPGL in full However, utmost care will be taken by TPGL to place order with the successful bidder considering transport of the materials.
- 9.3 Delivery of full quantity of filters at site shall be completed within 90 (ninety) days from the date of issue of the Letter of Award (LoA). The date of issue of Letter of Award (LoA) would be considered as zero date.
- 9.4 Successful bidder has to supply the approved components after being duly tested at the manufacturer's works in presence of TPGL representatives as specified in the LoA / subsequent letters.
- 9.5 Any delay in delivery except forced majeure shall be viewed seriously and may be linked with LD as found deem fit by TPGL.
- 9.6 The materials are to be supplied at specified locations at Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura, Tripura within the state of Tripura at the cost & risk of the successful bidder. TPGL will not provide any transit store during supply.

10 WORK EXECUTION:

- 10.1 Sr. Manager In Charge: Sr. Manager (Mechanical) Gas Thermal Mechanical Sub Division, Baramura or his authorised representative shall represent & act for the TPGL at all times during the execution of the contract.
- 10.2 CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIVE / CONSTRUCTION MANAGER: Within 15 (fifteen) days of the issue of LoA, the successful bidder shall appoint the bidder's representative and shall request the TPGL in writing to approve the person so appointed. The bidder's representative shall represent and act for the bidder at all time during the contract period. All Notices, instructions & all other communication made by TPGL or the Sr. Manager shall be given to the bidder's representative. The bidder shall not revoke the appointment of bidder's representative without the prior written consent of TPGL.





- 10.3 In absence of Contractor's representative, as mentioned above, a suitable person as substitute shall be appointed to act as his/her deputy.
- 10.4 TPGL may by Notice to the bidder object to any representative / person employed by the bidder in execution of the contract, who in the reasonable opinion of TPGL may behave in appropriately, may be incompetent or negligent or may commit serious breach of site regulations provided under the Contract. TPGL shall provide evidence of the same whereupon the bidder shall remove such person from the site and promptly appoint a replacement.

11 WORK PROGRAMME:

- 11.1 **PROGRAMME OF PERFORMANCE:**Within 20 (twenty) days after the date of issue of LoA, the bidder shall prepare & submit to TPGL for approval, a detailed programme of performance of the contract, made in form of PERT Network and showing the sequence in which it proposes to design, manufacture, testing & supply of filter elements for oil mist eliminator make- Dollinger for 21 MW Frame-V Gas Turbine Units at Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura, Tripura to enable him to execute the contract in accordance with the programme and to achieve completion & acceptance of the materials by TPGL in accordance with the contract. The PERT Network submitted showing the time schedule in accordance with the period specified in the contract shall be approved by TPGL.
- 11.2 **PROGRESS REPORT:**TPGL will monitor progress of all activities specified in the programme above and the bidder shall provide a progress report to TPGL in every week or as decided by Project Manager. The progress report shall be in a form acceptable to TPGL and shall also indicate completion achieved compared with planned completion for each activity and where any activity is behind the programme, giving comments & likely consequence and stating corrective actions being taken.
- 11.3 **WORK PROCEDURE:** The contract shall be executed in accordance with the contract documents. The bidder may be required to attend site progress review meeting organised by TPGL or authorised representative. The deliberations in the meetings shall interalia include progress of work, daily / weekly programme. Inputs to be provided by TPGL, delays, if any and recovery programme, specific hindrances to work and instruction by TPGL. The Minutes of meeting shall be recorded for reference.

12 COMPLETION TIME:

Time of completion for design, manufacture, testing & supply of coalescing filter elements with tank gasket for oil mist eliminator for 21 MW Frame-V Gas Turbine Units at Gas Thermal Power Station, Baramura, Tripura shall be 90 (ninety) days from the date of issue of LoA.

13 COMPLETION TIME GUARANTEE:

If the bidder fails to attain completion of work or any part thereof within the time for completion or any extension thereof, the successful bidder on whom LoA is made, the bidder shall pay to TPGL Liquidated Damages (LD) in the amount computed at the rates specified below. However, payment of Liquidated Damages shall not in any way relieve the bidder on whom award is made from any of its obligations to complete the work or from any other obligations and liabilities under the contract.

14 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

- 14.1 In case of any delay in the execution of the order beyond the stipulated time schedule decided including any extension permitted in writing, TPGL reserves the right to recover from the bidder a sum equivalent to 0.5 % of the value of the delayed equipment installation or on the unexecuted portion of the work for each week of the delay and part thereof subject to a maximum of 5% of the total value of the contract.
- 14.2 Alternatively, TPGL reserves the right to purchase materials and complete the works from elsewhere at the sole risk and cost of the successful bidder/ contractor and recover all such extra cost incurred by TPGL in procuring the material from resources available including EMD/Bid security/ encashment of the bank guarantee or any other sources etc. Further, if any extra cost is incurred by TPGL due to delay in completion of supply by the party beyond the completion





time as per LoA, the same shall be recovered from the successful bidder's Invoice/EMD/PBG etc.

- 14.3 TPGL may cancel the order completely or partly without prejudice to his right under the alternatives mentioned above.
- 15 The contractor/ bidder shall have to comply with all the Rules, Regulations, Laws and By-Laws for the time being in force and the instructions if any, of the organization, where the execution of work has to be done. "TPGL" shall have no liability in this regard.

16 FORCE MAJEURE CONDITIONS:

In the event of either party being rendered unable by force majeure to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under this agreement, relative obligation of the party affected by such force majeure shall be treated as suspended during which force majeure condition last.

- 16.1 The term force majeure shall herein mean riots (other than among the contractor's employee), civil commotion, war (whether declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemies hostilities, rebellion, insurrection, military coup to usurp power, Act of God such as earthquake, lightening, floods, fires not caused by contractor's negligence and other cause which the contractor has no control and accepted as such by the Managing Director, TPGL, whose decision shall be final and binding.
- 16.2 If the work is suspended by force majeure conditions lasting for more than 45 days, TPGL shall have the option of cancelling this contract in whole or part thereof, at its discretion. The contractor shall not claim for compensation for force majeure conditions.

17 LEGAL CASE:

All disputes are to be settled within the jurisdiction of High Court of Tripura, Agartala.

18 SUPERVISION / EXECUTION OF WORKS:

The works should be done as per direction of Deputy General Manager, Gas Thermal Electrical Division, Baramura /Sr. Manager (Mechanical) Gas Thermal Mechanical Sub-Division, Baramura. TPGL shall have at all reasonable time access to the works being carried out by the contractor/ bidder under the contract. All the work shall be carried out by the contractor/bidder to the satisfaction of TPGL.

- **19** The contractor/ bidder shall not, without the consent in writing of TPGL, transfer, assign or sublet the work under the contract or any substantial part thereof to any other party.
- 20 If any question, dispute or difference what so ever shall arises between TPGL and the contractor/ bidder, in the connection with the agreement except as to matters, the decisions for which have been specifically provided, either party may forthwith give to the other notice in writing of existence of such question, dispute or difference and the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator of TPGL. This reference shall be governed by the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996, and the Rules made there under. The award in such arbitration shall be final and binding on both proceedings unless the TPGL or the arbitrator directs otherwise.
- 21 TPGL may at any time by notice in writing to the contractor/bidder either stop the work all together or reduce or cut it down. If the work is stopped all together, the contractor/bidder will only be paid for work done and expenses distinctly incurred by him as on preparation or the execution of the work up to the date on which such notice is received by him. Such expenses shall be assessed by TPGL, whose decision shall be final and bidding on the contractor/ bidder. If the work is cut down the contractor/ bidder will not be paid any compensation what so ever for the loss or profit which he might have made if he had been allowed to complete all the work included in the contract.
- 22 **EXPENSES OF AGREEMENT**: A formal agreement shall be entered into between TPGL and the contractor/ bidder for the proper fulfilment of the contract. The expenses of completing and stamping of the agreement shall be paid by the successful bidder.

23 INSPECTION AND TESTING OF MATERIALS:

23.1 Prior to placing formal order, pre inspection of the manufacturing unit of the bidder eligible for getting the work may be made by the officials of TPGL.





- 23.2 All materials / equipments manufactured by the bidder against LoA shall be subject to inspection, check and / or test by TPGL at all stages and place, before, during and after the manufacture. All these tests shall be carried out as per technical specification and bidder shall submit relevant test reports.
- 23.3 The materials will be despatched by the successful bidder after pre-despatch inspection as felt necessary by Deputy General Manager, Gas Thermal Electrical Division, Baramura or his representatives on behalf of TPGL at the factory /works of the successful bidder as per NIe-T specifications and acceptance of the same.
- 23.4 The successful bidder shall provide without any extra charge, all materials, tools, testing equipments, labour and assistance of every kind which the inspecting officer may consider necessary for any test or examination which he may require to be made on the successful bidder's premises or at site.
- 23.5 All the expenses for the inspection of Coalescing Filter Elements (At the bidder's premises / manufacturing unit) by the two representatives of TPGL like to & fro air fare, boarding and lodging charges etc. will have to be borne by the successful bidder.
- 23.6 <u>The successful bidder should not despatch any component to site without getting despatch</u> <u>clearance from TPGL.</u>
- 23.7 If <u>upon delivery whether inspected and approved earlier or otherwise, the materials are found</u> not in conformity with the specification, the same shall be rejected by TPGL and notification to this effect will be issued to the bidder normally within 7 (seven) days from the date of delivery of materials at site.
- 23.8 <u>The bidder shall arrange removal of the rejected items within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of notification and take necessary action for replacement at the cost & risk of the bidder.</u>

24 PACKING FORWARDING:

grated on this account.

- 24.1 Contractor/ bidders, wherever applicable, shall after proper painting, pack and crate all the materials in such a manner as to protect them from deterioration and damage during rail and road transportation to the site and storage at the site till time of installation. Contractor/bidder shall be sole responsible for all damage due to improper packing.
- 24.2 The contractor/ bidder shall inform the TPGL of the date of each shipment from his works, and the expected date of arrival at the site for the information of TPGL at least 7 days in advance.

25 **RESPONSIBILITY OF TRANSPORTATION AND STORES:** Successful bidder should be solely responsible for stores during transit if required. Normally materials shall be dispatched on full truck container. Any legal interference of Police / Sales tax / Income tax / Transport / Any other Govt. Agencies will be faced by successful bidder. The transportation delay / non availability of truck etc. will never be considered by the tendering authority as reason of delay to supply and naturally no extension of delivery period will be

26 INSURANCE:

- 26.1 The Bidder shall be responsible and take an Insurance Policy for transit-cum-storage-cumerection for all the materials to cover all risks and liabilities for supply of materials on site basis, installation at site,. The bidder shall also take appropriate insurance during warranty period.
- 26.2 In case of any loss or damage or pilferage or theft or fire accident or combination of the said incidents etc. under the coverage of insurance, the Contractor shall lodge the claim as per rules of insurance. Any FIR required to be lodged to Police Station shall be the responsibility of the bidder.
- 26.3 The bidder shall arrange to supply/recover the materials even if the claim is unsettled for timely completion of the Project. The final financial settlement with the insurance company shall be rested upon the Contractor.
- 27 Insurance as applicable for filter elements during operation of GT Units for covering risk against any mishap to its workmen, TPGL will not be responsible for any such loss or non-

performance. All other insurance like, Contractor All Risk, insurance against theft and acts of GOD, as required warranty period of Filter Elementss and to indemnify the TPGL material and resources shall be borne by the contractor.

28 TERMINATION FOR INSOLVENCY:

TPGL may at any time terminate the contract by giving written notice to the contractor/bidder without compensation to the contractor/ bidder, if it becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy, which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to TPGL.

29 TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE:

TPGL, may by written notice sent to the contractor/ bidder, terminate the contract, in whole or in part at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the purchaser's convenience in the interest of TPGL.

30 APPLICABLE LAW:

The contractor/ bidder shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the purchaser's country i.e. India. The station of TPGL Headquarter at Agartala shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under this contract.

31 PRE-BID MEETING:

- 31.1 The bidder(s) or their authorized representative(s) may be invited to attend the pre-bid meeting to be held in the Head Quarter of TPGL at Agartala, which will take place on the date as specified in the Bid information sheet.
- 31.2 Only 1 (one) representative of 1 (one) bidder with valid Authorization Letter can attend the prebid meeting.
- 31.3 The purpose of the pre-bid meeting will be to clarify any issue regarding the NIe-T including in particular, issues raised in writing as per **FORMAT 6** and submitted by the bidders on or before **18/09/2023 upto 17:00 Hrs** through e-mail:<u>brmgtps@gmail.com</u>.
- 31.4 TPGL may postpone pre-bid meeting, in which case the prospective bidders may seek clarification as mentioned above, the reply of which will below given through portal.
- 31.5 TPGL is not under any obligation to entertain/respond to suggestions made or to incorporate modifications sought for.

32 NOTICE:

- 32.1 Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to the contract shall be sent in writing, soft copy should be forwarded through e-mail & hard copy through Speed Post / Courier to the address specified for that purpose.
- 32.2 A notice shall be effective when delivered or on the notice's effective date, whichever is later.

33 PAYMENT & OTHER FINANCIAL TERMS:

- 33.1 No advance payment will be made.
- 33.2 Contractor shall prefer 100% payment against the supply of full quantity of materials in all respect.
- 33.3 All payments shall be made in Indian Rupees through NEFT/RTGS only for which successful bidder has to submit Bank Details as and when asked for.

34 PLANT PERFORMANCE EVALUATION:

TPGL may monitor the performance of the Filter Elements supplied by the bidder. TPGL shall maintain periodic parameters such as differential pressure across filter element for evaluation of Performance.

35 COMPLIANCE WITH LABOUR REGULATIONS:

During execution of the Contract (during manufacturing process at his works/factory), the successful bidder shall abide at all times by all existing labour enactments and Rules made there under, regulations, notifications and by laws of the State Government or Central Government or local authority and any other labour law (including rules), regulations, by laws that may be



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passed or notification that may be issued under any labour law in future either by the State Government or the Central Government or the local authority.

36 STATUTORY RESPONSIBILITY:
